VINTAGE NOTES

The Bennett Valley AVA in Sonoma County has become renowned for the quality of its Syrah. The Serenity Way Vineyard where we source our Syrah is high in elevation with steep, south and southwest aspects. This vineyard is located on the first home ranch for Flanagan Wines. It is one of the warmest and rockiest sites in Bennett Valley.

TASTING NOTES

We love the varietal character of this wine and because of the ripeness we get from our site, we get a lush flavor profile and silky ripe tannins. This 2007 Syrah was barrel fermented and aged for 18 months in a blend of Ermitage and Taransaud French oak barrels made from the Allier and Vosges forests.
