VINTAGE NOTES

The severe lack of rain at the end of 2020 led to very weak shoot growth and low crop yields in 2021. This will continue to affect the vines in 2022. All that aside, the fires that started August 18th had the largest impact on the 2020 growing season. On August 21st the fires reached the ridge line about 1000 yards behind our estate vineyards.

TASTING NOTES

Sourced from one of Dad's top sites my 2021 Pinot Noir is a beautiful, well balanced, cool climate expression of Pinot Noir. The wine has a lovely orange blossom note on the nose. The palate has subtle hints of umami mixed with black cherry and cassis. I love the balance between the bright fruit and the earth notes!

This wine has an elegant structure and is a great example of top notch Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir!
